An Hour in Prayer

Praise

Psalm 63:3 ~ Praise is the vocal adoration of God by rendering honor, esteem and love for who God is.

Waiting

Psalm 46:10 ~ Waiting is silent soul surrender. Waiting says softly, "I love you." Simply slow down and be aware of and experience the closeness of God.

Confession

Psalm 139:23 ~ Confession is temple-cleansing time. Ask God to search your heart for any unconfessed sin as you mentally examine your recent activities.

Scripture Reading

Jeremiah 23:29 ~ Examine a passage from the Gospels or from Psalms. Develop actual prayers based on these thoughts and offer these confidently to God.

Watching

Colossians 4:2 ~ Watching means to be on guard for the spiritual attacks of Satan. Prayerfully ask God for power to defeat Satan in each of these areas.

Intercession

1 Timothy 2:1,2 ~ Pray for others and especially for the lost. Ask God for laborers, finances, and for a soul harvest.

Petition

Matthew 7:7 ~ Asking God for specific personal spiritual or physical needs and desires that will bring honor to God.

Thanksgiving

1 Thessalonians 5:18 ~ Thank God for all He has given you in recent days. Frequently thank God in advance for blessings you expect Him to give you.

Singing

Psalm 100:2 ~ Sing a song to God or ask the Holy Spirit to help you create a new song for the Lord.

Meditation

Joshua 1:8 ~ The act of spiritual evaluation. Select a theme for meditation. Ask God to lead you and let your mind wander on this theme.

Listening

Ecclesiastes 5:2 ~ Ask God specific questions, search scriptures and listen to the still, small voice of the Spirit for answers.

Praise

Psalm 52:9 ~ End your prayer time with praising Him for His greatness and for being with you and hearing each aspect of your prayer.
